#### Trash Pick Up

Dear Residents of Kimberly:

Western Waste Services Kimberly's new waste management provide; started on October 1st, 2008. Each household was issued one 95 gallon residential garbage cart. Business trash collection using 95 gallon carts is also available. Western automated utilizes an collection system, in which all waste must be placed in your 95-gallon cart. Western will only be collecting tree limbs (no longer than 4 feet and under 65 pounds) which are properly cut, bundled, tied and placed next to the cart.

# WHAT CAN I PUT IN MY GARBAGE CART AND HOW OFTEN IS IT COLLECTED?

Household garbage should be bagged before placing in the cart. By placing your garbage in plastic bags you will keep your cart clean and minimize odors. **Do not put hot ashes or coals in your cart.** 

### WHEN IS MY TRASH PICK-UP DAY?

If your home is located on the West side of Main Street your trash will be picked up on Wednesday's. If your home is located on the East side of Main Street, your trash pick up days are on Monday's.

(Holidays will be a day behind).

#### HOW DO I DISPOSE OF TRASH THAT DOESN.T FIT IN MY CART?

household generates more than 95 gallons of waste per week. To help make the City's transition easier, bagged trash placed next to your cart will be collected through the end of November. Starting December 1st, 2008, all waste must be contained in 95 gallon carts provided by Western.

## WHEN AND WHERE DO I PLACE THE CART ON COLLECTION DAY?

Starting October 1, 2008 trash collection in alleyways will no longer be offered. Customers should move the cart(s) to the front curb the night before trash day, but no later than 7:00 a.m. on your collection day. Place the cart near or on the curb and at least three feet away from your mail box, utility poles, trees, cars, sprinkler heads or anything collection equipment could damage. Always place the cart at curb with wheels and handle facing your residence. When your cart is delivered, it will be placed in the best location for weekly pickup. Promptly remove your cart from the curb to keep it from being damaged or stolen.

#### MAY I USE MY OWN CART OR GARBAGE CAN?

No. The roll-out carts provided are specifically designed to withstand the forces of the mechanical gripper. Other cans will not be emptied. We look forward to serving you!
