Greetings friends and neighbors,

We are off to a wonderful start for a beautiful summer and I hope that this letter finds you all in good health. I would like to thank everyone for their questions and feedback, which I get on a regular basis. Here is an update on some of the things are going on in our city.

<u>RV Disposal Site</u>- this project has been awarded and the final stages of planning are underway. As soon as the plans are finalized construction should begin. Jeff McCurdy from region IV is our liaison and the one responsible for making the things around this project come together.

<u>Red Cap corner project</u>- This project has been awarded funding from the parties involved and once the funding has been allocated to its final destination, construction will begin. Our hope is that construction will begin as early as the end of September or the 1st of October. Thank you to JUB for their diligence in pursuing all aspects of this project.

Safe routes to school- I don't know how many folks are familiar with this project and what it entails. This project is one that has been and will still be managed and accomplished by Jan Hall, Jamie Carlton and Kathleen Noh. The funding of this project is from two sources outside of the City of Kimberly and addresses the issues of our much needed sidewalks, from the Flashing light intersection at Maverick and Fast way 66 and runs south all the way to Gem Drive. This project will be addressed in three phases. It will include not only sidewalks, but curb and gutter on both sides of the road and a chip seal on the road. During the last election, as I was going door to door, one of the very big concerns I heard was the lack of a safe route to school from many, many folks from the south end of town. This is a start, and a good one at that for providing safety for our children, Thank you, ladies, for your efforts and your commitment to this project.
