I am very pleased to present the Kimberly-Hansen Police Department year end status report for 2015. It has been an exciting year for our agency and we are very proud of the professional services that we have rendered to our great community.

Emergency services demands increase with population growth. As you read through the documents provided you will see how effective police services have been this year for our community. We had a record number of drug arrests, as well as DUI. Our crimes against persons are down, while crimes against property did have an increase.

We have a great working relationship with surrounding Law Enforcement and Emergency Service Agencies and have continued to provide valuable assistance when needed. They too, have assisted our agency on numerous calls for service. Having our officers respond to emergency calls other than those that are law enforcement orientated shows that we are dedicated to all facets of community safety and the citizens can see their offices from a different perspective.

Community input is vital to the success of any department and we value any input from our citizens. Their suggestions, issues, and concerns are always listened too. A citizens input on crime and officers representation is extremely important and we value the partnership that we have with our community that allows us to serve them better.

With our service area broken into three different zones, we can pin point criminal activity more accurately so that any needed extra patrol can be moved from area to area. The city of Kimberly is broken into two areas with Center Street as the divider. Area One is the west bound lane of Center Street through the North end of the city. Area Two is the East bound lane of Center Street through the South end of the city. Area Three is Hansen. As the cities grow, these boundaries may change depending on the area of growth.

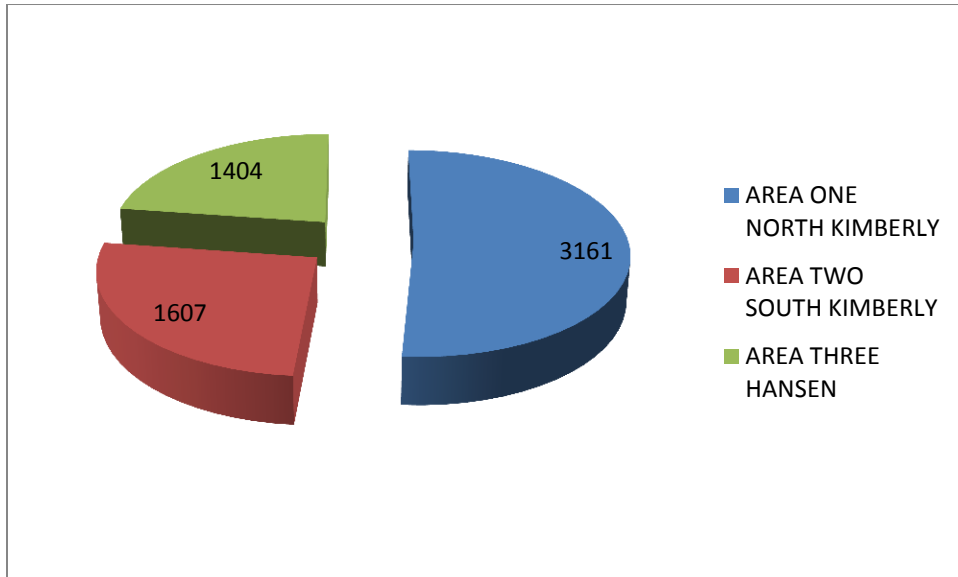

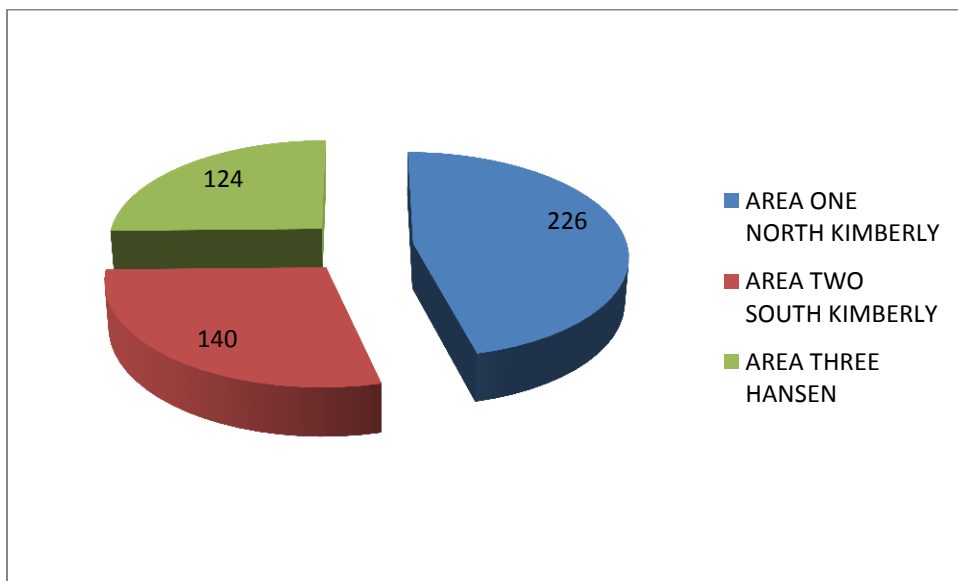

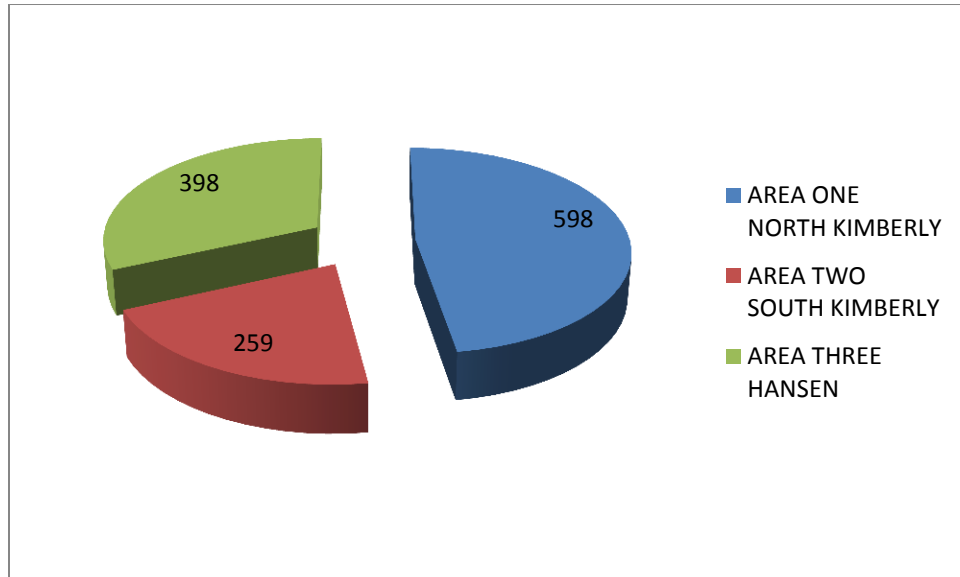

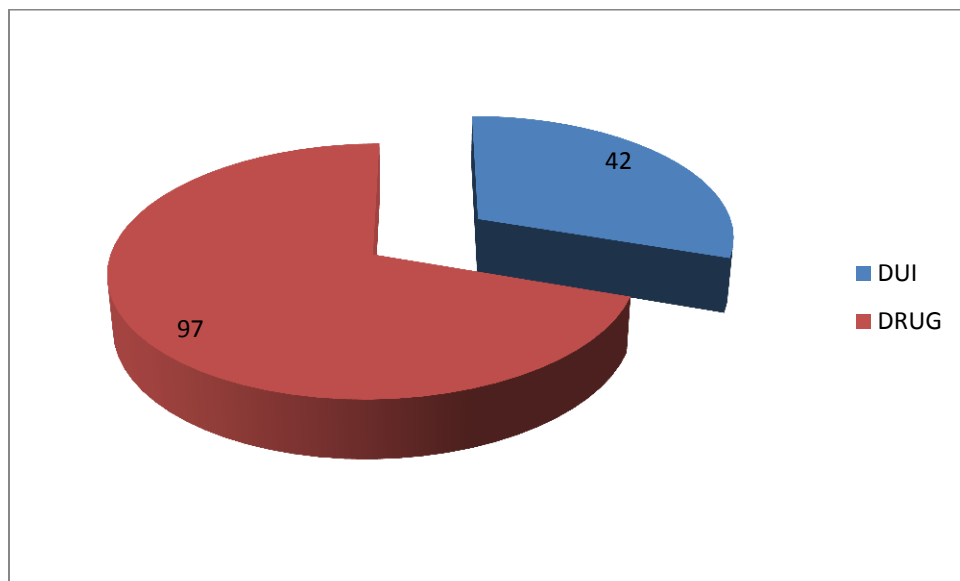

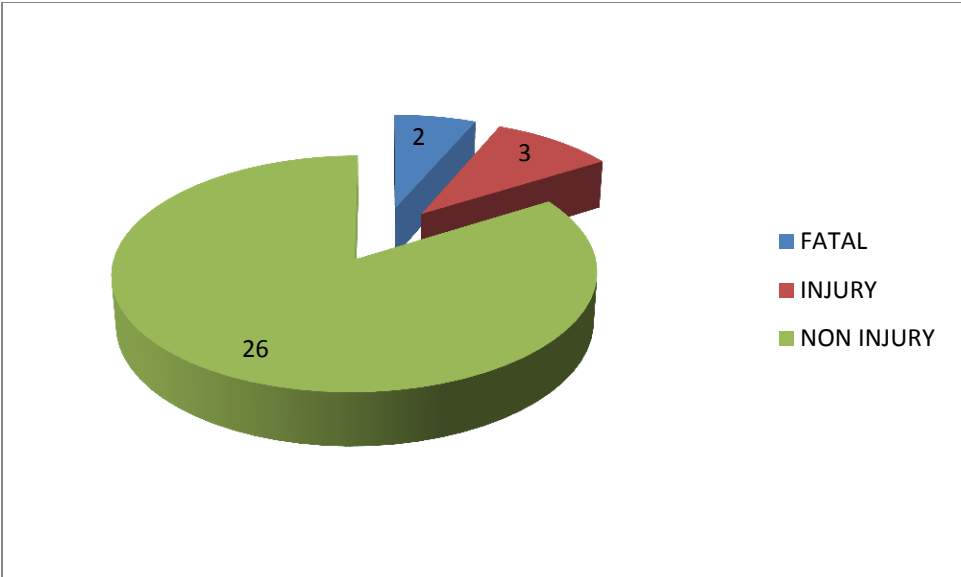

NARCOTICS AND DRIVING UNDER THE INFLUENCE



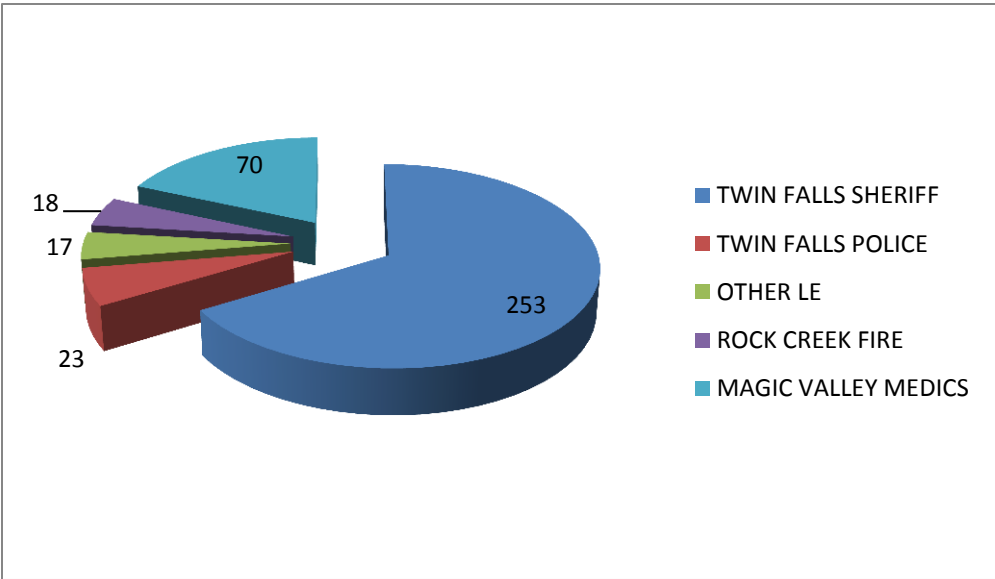

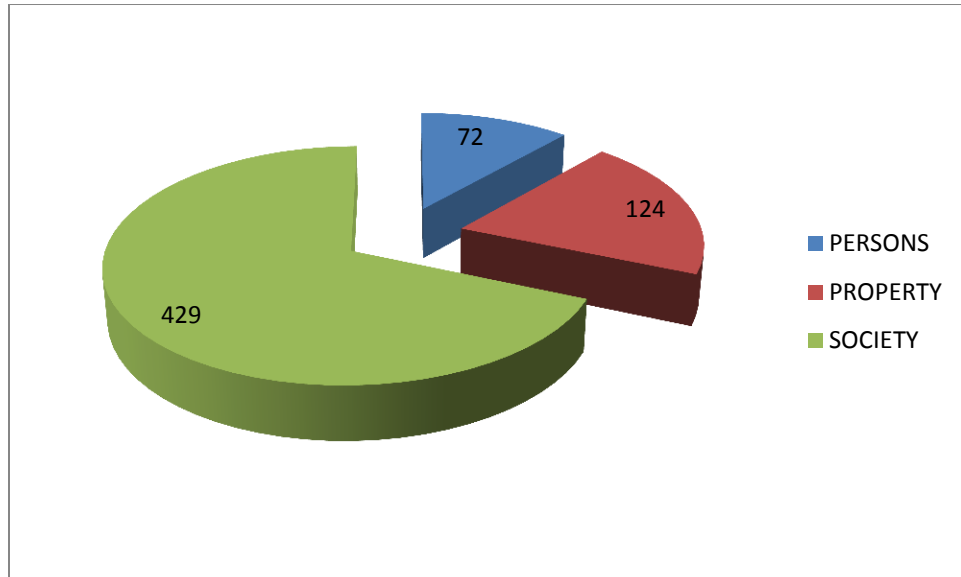

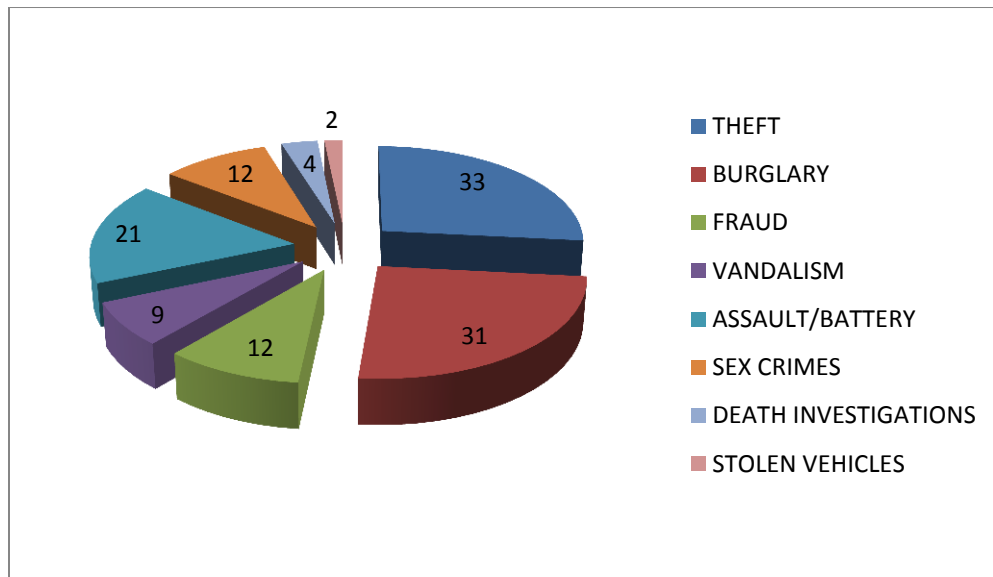

CRIMINAL ACTIVITY BREAKDOWN



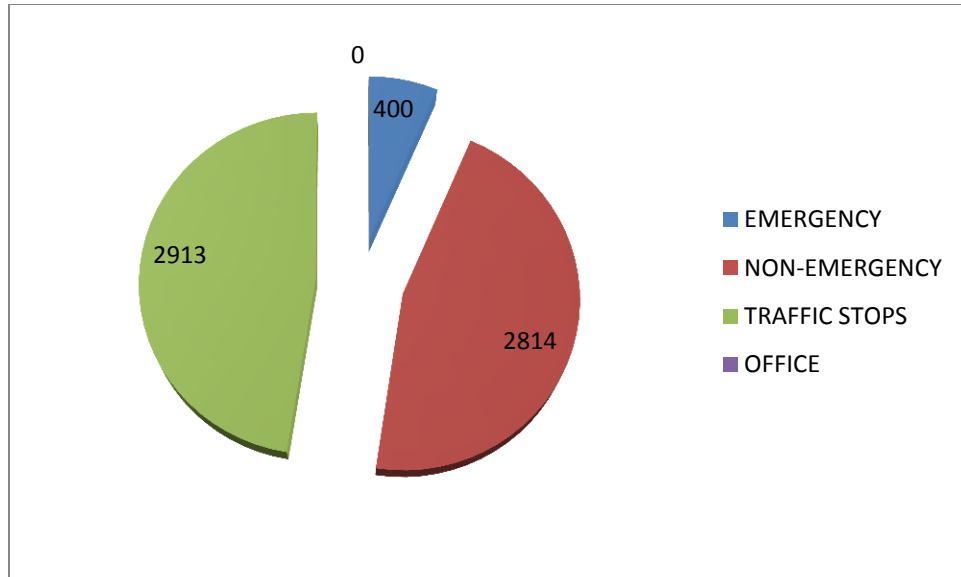

BREAKDOWN OF INVESTIGATIONS



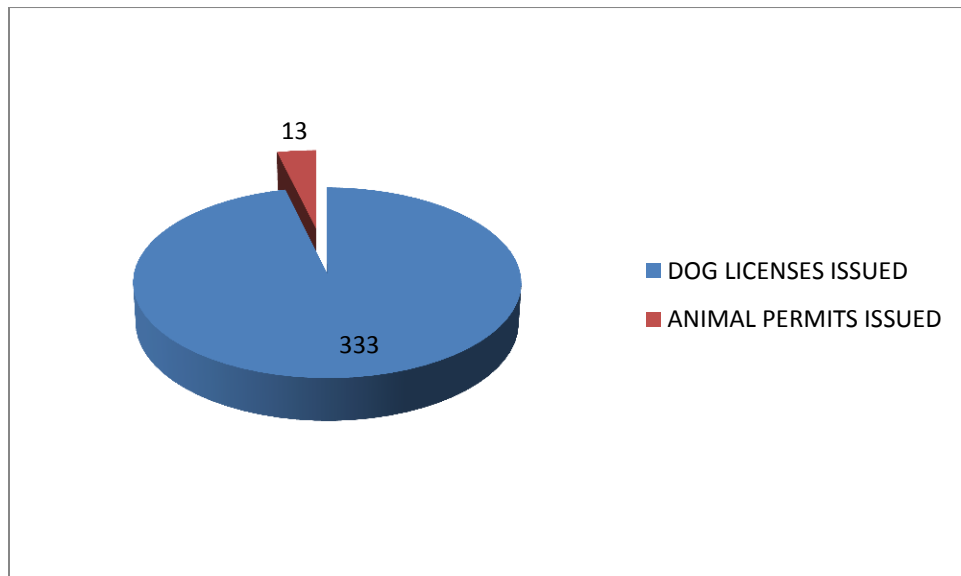

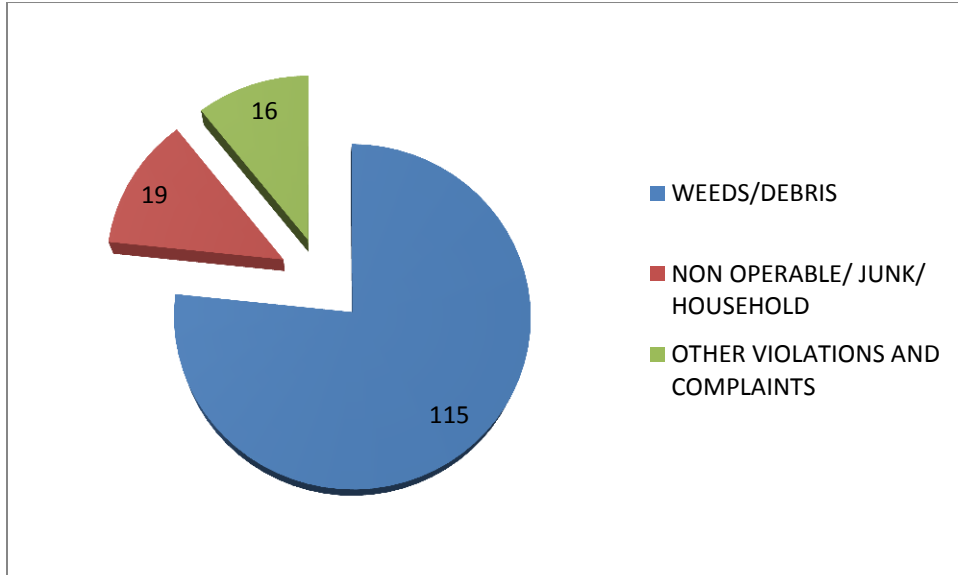

ANIMAL CONTROL LICENSES ISSUED



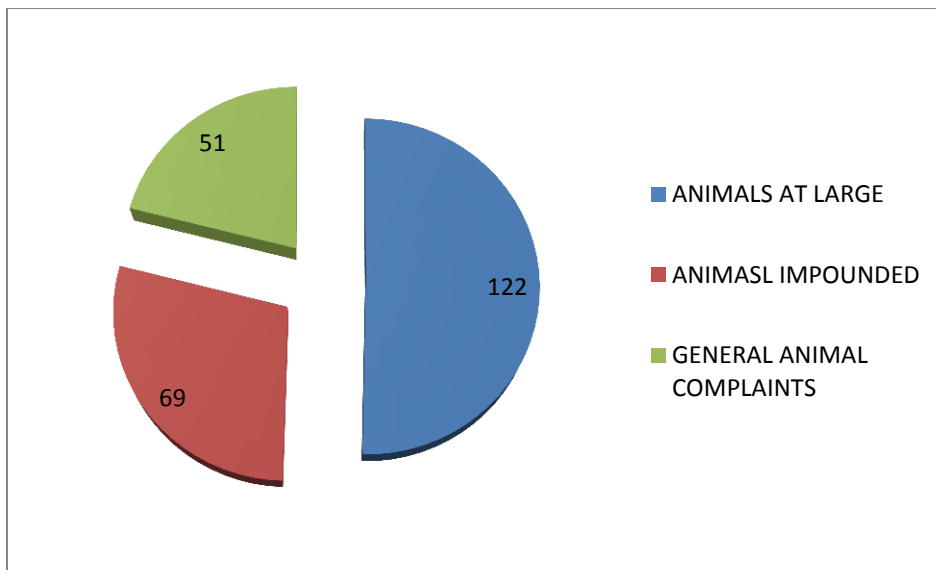

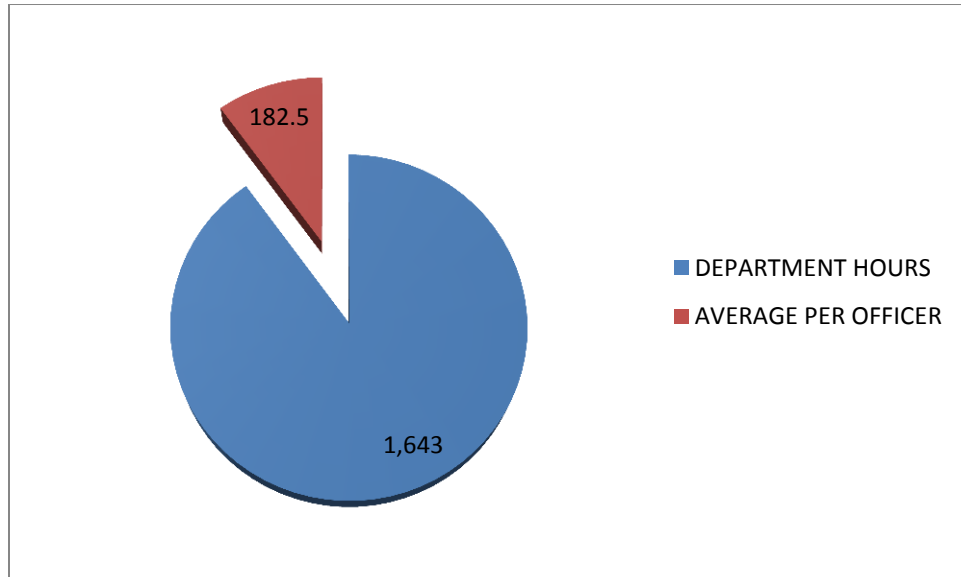

ANIMALS AT LARGE AND IMPOUNDS



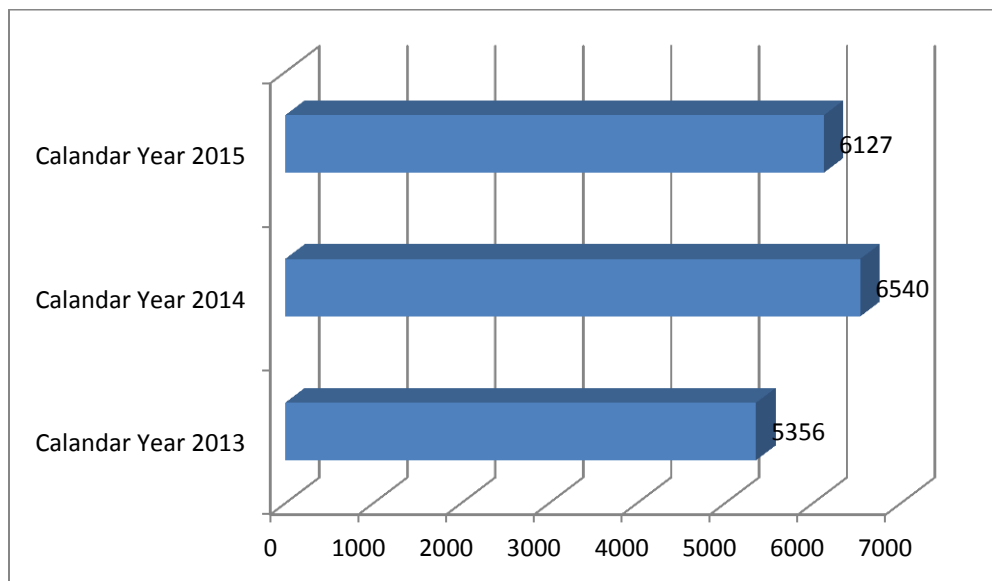

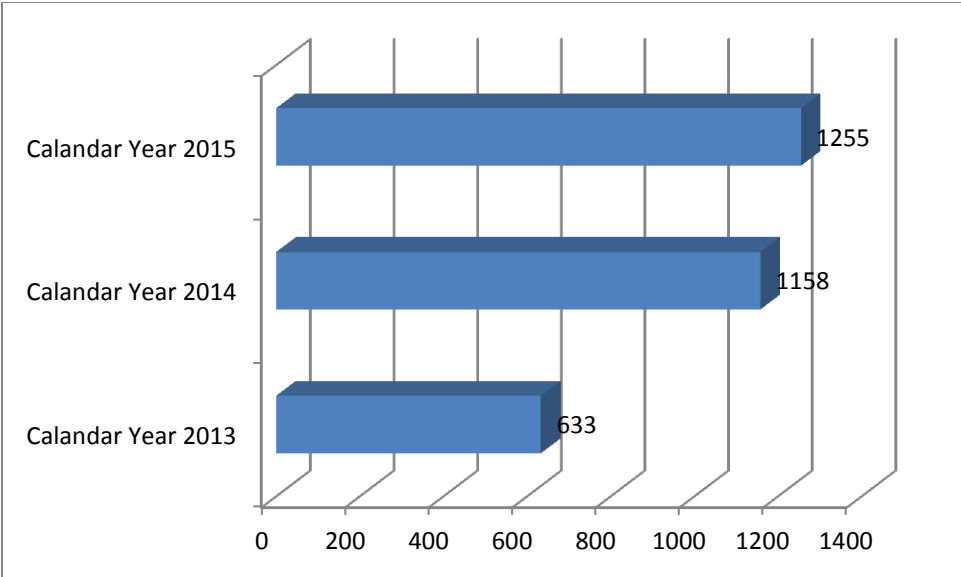
